






Employee Headcount Trend






- YTD Growth of IP Volume(Including Daycare) is 16% and budget achievement of 91%.(H1 FY 24 vs H1 FY23)






- Consistent growth in OPD volume in Q1 and Q2 FY 24 leading to an overall growth of 15% in H1 FY 24 vs H1 FY 23

Overview: Revenue






